

Nicastri ready for title challenge

Victory in Round 3 of the NSW Late Model Series at Tyrepower Sydney Speedway November 27 has Ross Nicastri fired up and confident of a good result in the Kurrajong Shell Service Station NSW Late Model Championship at Brobenah Raceway Leeton (NSW) Saturday December 18.

“We enjoyed a great run at Tyrepower Sydney Speedway November 27. We had to work hard all night just to get on top of the track, let alone the opposition, so it was a good test just prior to the NSW title” team principal and driver Ross Nicastri stated.

The Frank’s Auto Parts / Bill Martin Dyno Tune / 13 Used #99 Mastersbilt took victory in Heat 1, finished second in Heat 2, and raced to the win in the Feature after a tough tussle with Nathan Disney.

“I had to find the smooth line around a particularly rough track so to come away with the victory was very satisfying. We will be going over the entire car between now and December 18, as we want to ensure we give the NSW title our best shot”.

“It’s great to see the Kurrajong Shell Service Station NSW Late Model Championship being held at arguably one of Australia’s fastest tracks. The oiled dirt surface at Leeton throws up its own unique challenge, as it’s not the normal type of track surface these powerful cars race on. Having said that, everyone is in the same boat, and I’m sure there will be plenty of fine tuning in the Heats as drivers chase the perfect setup for the 20 lap Feature”.

“I feel the Nicastri Motorsport team is in a pretty good position heading into the title. I’m confident in saying that we have had more track time than any of our rivals this season and that has given us the opportunity to rectify any early season car

problems. It's also allowed me the opportunity to hone my driving skills, as nothing beats a hard campaign to get you up to speed" Nicastri said.

"The Leeton Motor Sports Club is going out of its way to promote the title and ensure it is highly successful for all concerned. It's terrific to be supporting their endeavours, and great to be racing at a country facility, as they are the real backbone of the sport across the nation".

In other Nicastri Motorsport news it has been confirmed that Ben Nicastri will drive the #99 at the NSW Late Models Round scheduled for Nowra Speedway (NSW) January 1.

Ross Nicastri has also secured a deal to race an Allan Blake owned Late Model in Western Australia over the new year period. Ross will compete in two R2C Competition Series Filters Pro Dirt Rounds at Bunbury City Speedway (Sunday December 26) and Manjimup Speedway (Sunday January 2). More information will be released closer to the dates.
