Race Format: Hot Laps, 2 Lap qualifying per car to seed heats (points for qualifying as per schedule below). 2 x 10 lap heat races per car. 1st Heat grid as per qualifying order, 2nd heat reverse grid.

B-Main if req. (top 4 transfer to rear of A-main).

Victorian Late Model Championship A-Main = Minimum 30 Laps.

Maximum 24 cars (top 20 qualifiers, 4 x B-Main transfers) to start in the A-Main. The only non qualifier eligible to start in the A-Main event would be the current Victorian Champion (if they have competed in the heats); they would then start R.O.F. in the Feature. If that occurred, only the top 3 from the B-Main would transfer to retain the maximum 24 car field.

MOTOR RACING IS DANGEROUS

I agree to participate at this Late Model Racing Victoria Inc. (hereby known as LMRV) event and by nominating; I hereby agree to abide by the rules and regulations as per LMA rules, the Constitution and any supplementary rules, by-laws and regulations of LMRV Association (LMRV can provide a copy of these if required) the host track rules and I also hereby agree to abide by all decisions made by the Chief Steward on the night and any decision made by LMRV on the night. NOTE: LMRV and/or organisers reserve the right to change/alter race procedure at any time as deemed necessary. LMRV reserve the right to refuse a nomination; without any reason being given. For all heats and final LMRV use the point system 36, 28, 23 etc. If any car retires infield during a heat race or final, points and/or prize money will only be allocated to that car if it has completed 50% of advertised race distance and in order of any retirement. Any car that does not reach 50% of advertised race distance during a heat or final will be classed as a DNF. Qualifying points are as per schedule below. As per LMRV supplementary rules, any drivers new to the Late Model division are subject to ROF starts in the heats until deemed race competent by the LMRV Executives. LMRV By-Laws state that any driver deemed by the Chief Steward to be the primary cause of 2 stoppages in the same heat/final will be disqualified (no points/prize regardless if 50% completed) from that heat/final and sent to the infield. LMRV reserve the right to change/alter any conditions of entry or supplementary regulations at any time as deemed necessary for this event. LMRV reserves the right to use images, names and information of all entrants and their vehicles in a variety of media platforms for the promotion of this event by LMRV or any of its authorised delegates.

Qualifying points schedule:

(Qualifying for the Victorian Title: cars will be split into separate flights therefore max. points will be based off car count for each individual flight).

Max. points for qualifying will be based off cars numbers in attendance per flight multiplied by two. Amount of cars x 2 points will be top point amount, decreasing by 2 points per position (example: if 10 cars in a flight = 20 points for quick time in that flight, 18 for 2nd quick, 16 for 3rd quick etc) .

Note: If any car fails to take their allocated pill draw position and/or flight group for qualifying, they will be disqualified, no points allocated and ROF starts in both heats.

If any car fails to participate in qualifying, ROF starts in both heats.

Please note that there is the opportunity for any interested Late Model teams to participate in a Street Parade on the Sunday morning (27th Jan).
